



Fiduciary Responsibility

- The financial health of a chapter is key to a chapter's long-term success.
- Chapter officers have a <u>fiduciary responsibility</u> to The WICT Network's partners and members.
- This is a legal and ethical obligation to safeguard chapter assets and to comply with regulations.



The WICT Network IRS Tax Structure

- All of The WICT Network's domestic chapters are under a "Group Exemption" from the IRS with a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status.
- The WICT Network's Federal Tax ID # is 36-3814358.
- The WICT Network's Group Return's Federal Tax ID # is 36-3539302.
- All chapters have their own unique Tax ID numbers.
- Chapters are permitted by the IRS to issue tax receipts to donors for contributions.
 - Template letters to donors and sponsors are posted to the Chapter Leader Resource Directory for your use.
 - Must list the non-tax deductible amounts for goods or services received by the donor.



Local Tax and Compliance Issues

Sales tax on purchases

- The WICT Network Global office has a sales tax exemption in DC, NY, MA and the city of Denver.
- Chapters must apply for their own sales tax exemptions.
- Generally based on business being conducted in that state by the chapter.
- Contact The WICT Network Global office if you run into issues.

Sales and use tax for items sold

- The WICT Network Global office is not licensed for sales and use tax since we do not sell items.
- Chapters must apply for their own sales and use tax licenses if needed.
- Contact The WICT Network Global office if you run into issues.

Events

- The WICT Network's insurance broker can provide you with a certificate of insurance for liability. Contact: Bill Coady, Walterry Insurance Brokers, bcoady@walterry.com
- There are IRS requirements for reporting giveaways and prizes.
- There may also be local and/or state rules and regulations on events.



New Treasurer Checklist

- Schedule a meeting with past Chapter Treasurer
- Update Signature Cards with Bank/Meet with Bank Representative
- Review the financial responsibilities document on the Chapter Leader Resource Directory which includes:
 - Credit card expense reports and receipt retention guidelines
 - Internal Controls for Chapter Treasurers
 - Chapter Volunteer Treasurer Guidelines
 - Prize Promotion Guidelines Sweepstakes, Contests or Raffles
- Review prior year Model Chapter Business Plan (MCBP)
- Become familiar with online registration process

MCBP Sarbanes-Oxley Compliance

- Found in the Governance Section:
 - Document Retention & Destruction policy
 - Whistleblower policy
 - Conflict of Interest policy
- Each policy to be implemented in each chapter
 - Must be adopted by your board
 - Guidance page signed by chapter presidents
 - Designee to collect and retain signed documents from all other volunteer leaders



MCBP IRS 990 Compliance

- Found in the Finance Section
 - Financial activity form complete by March 22



Additional Information

Chapter rebates

- Rebate of 15% of dues collected paid in three payments as a percent of total chapter member dues. Payments are made in May, September, and January. Chapters who exceed their annual membership goal by 10%+ will receive an extra rebate incentive.
- Administered through BILL (online bill payment platform).

PCI Compliance

- Do not keep credit card numbers from payments received.
- Obscure or shred credit card numbers from any forms you keep on file.

The WICT Network charitable contributions

- Chapters are encouraged to support The WICT Network annually.
- Supports The WICT Network programming, including providing leadership training and education to members.

• 1099s

- You must issue IRS 1099 tax forms to your vendors.
